

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

It is important to read these Terms & Conditions before completing your entry form.

1. ENTRY

By entering the Event, you agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions of Entry and any instructions given to you by the organisers and officials of the Event. It is a condition of entry that you consent to the publication of your name, race number and time following the race. Please submit your entry to us no later than 17 August 2012 as this ensures you will receive your race pack on time. If you enter after this date you must collect your race pack in person from the race office on 31 August.

2. HOW TO ENTER

Please note entry fee is non-refundable, non-transferable and nor can it be deferred to a future date.

- > Carefully complete ALL sections of the entry form.
- > Please ensure you include the address you wish all mailings to be sent including your race pack.
- > We will acknowledge your entry within 10 days of the receipt date.
- > You will receive your race pack approximately 10 days before the race.
- > Please notify us of any change of address as soon as possible.

Please note you must be between 9 and 17 years old on the day of the race.

3. WHEELCHAIR & DISABLED ENTRANTS

Wheelchair racers will be allocated a position if we are advised - all wheelchair entrants should check the appropriate box on the entry form/ system. No pets, dogs or horses - only entrants with a guide dog or hearing dog will be permitted and if we are advised, a position at the rear of the field will be allocated.

4. SAFETY

For reasons of safety, no entries please from people on roller skates, roller blades, in beds, on stilts, wheelbarrows, pushchairs, carrying various objects for charity etc.

5. HEALTH

By entering the Event, you are declaring that you are medically fit to run and participate in the Event.
