## Entry requirements

Grades A or B at National 5 level.

The Higher course consists of 3 units:

- Scottish History. Migration and Empire 1830-1939
- British History. Britain 1851-1951
- European and the World History. Appeasement and the Road to War, to 1939

At Higher, the course assessment consists of 3 components: a unit assessment for each unit must be passed, an assignment worth $33 \%$ of the final mark must be completed and the final exam paper.
